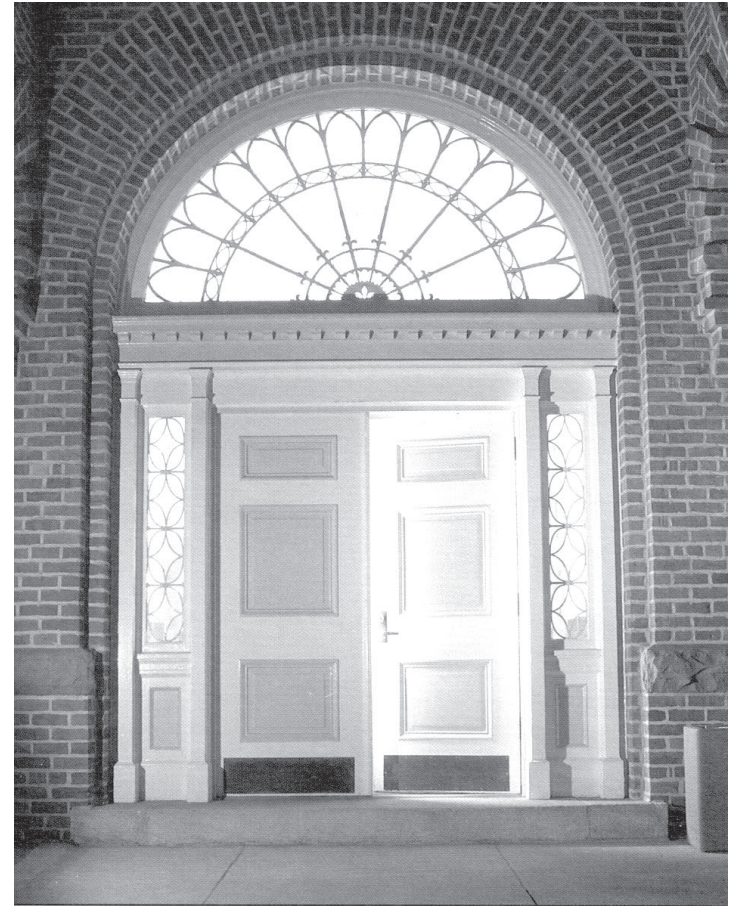

DEPARTMENTAL AWARDS FOR TEACHING AND LEARNING EXCELLENCE

The Departmental Awards for Teaching and Learning Excellence were established in the 1999-2000 academic year. Each year, up to two departments are recognized for their exceptional collective accomplishments in teaching and learning. Nominations are made by college deans, and dossiers supporting these nominations are reviewed by a committee of faculty, students, and staff appointed by the provost. Each department identified for this award receives a continuing base budget adjustment of \$15,000 and a one-time award of \$5,000.

Department of Statistics

The NC State University Department of Statistics has grown into one of the largest undergraduate statistics programs in the country and the largest graduate statistics program in the world. This growth could not have occurred without excellent teaching, mentoring and advising. Indeed, excellence in teaching and learning is a central priority of the Department of Statistics. The department has made major efforts to supplement excellent classroom instruction with out-of-classroom programs and resources that support and enhance students' educational experiences, including mentoring, advising and study groups. The Statistics Education Research Cluster, the StatTeach Working Group, and four teaching professors are active in the department's teaching and learning initiatives. Outstanding teaching is under-girded by the department's extensive network of consult-

ing, research collaborations and outreach. The department has sought and earned highly competitive educational initiative grants, which to-date have generated over \$5 million in funding to support its teaching programs. Collectively, these grants are designed to strengthen and broaden offerings for their own students, facilitate outreach to new pools of students who wish to integrate statistics into their undergraduate and/or graduate coursework, and disseminate teaching materials at NC State and other statistics departments across the country. These grants also supplement their specific, sustained efforts to recruit, retain and mentor talented students from underrepresented groups from the high school to the post-doctoral and tenure-track level. Throughout these initiatives, the Department of Statistics remains committed to the rigorous assessment of classroom teaching and the overall efficacy of their undergraduate and graduate programs.

Medal Recipients for 2005

C. Frank Abrams, Professor of Biological and Agricultural Engineering; Professor of Biomedical Engineering; and Director of Graduate Programs for Biomedical Engineering



Dr. Frank Abrams has devoted 33 years to research, teaching, service, and administration at NC State. He has furthered the university's land grant legacy and supported the state's agricultural enterprises through his investigations of ways to improve crop mechanization, and he has conducted pioneering research in biomedical engineering. He served as elected Chair of the Faculty, led the Department of Biological and Agricultural Engineering to broaden its perspective on the linkage between engineering and biology, and led development of the new Department of Biomedical Engineering, a partnership between NC State and UNC-Chapel Hill and the first joint department in the UNC System.

A visionary academic administrator, Dr. Abrams provided instrumental leadership in the encouragement of high quality teaching and learning, making long-term impact in such areas as distance education, university-wide course evaluation, the establishment of the Faculty Center for Teaching and Learning, and reappointment, tenure, and promotion policy. He co-wrote the initial grant proposal to the Hewlett Foundation that created the Inquiry-Guided Learning (IGL) Program, which built on grassroots faculty interest in teaching in ways that encourage students' critical thinking and has brought the university national recognition for educational innovation.

Sarah Burke Berenson, Professor of Mathematics Education; Director, Center for Research in Mathematics and Science Education



Dr. Sarah Burke Berenson has dedicated nearly 20 years at NC State, building a nationally and internationally recognized mathematics education program. Known for her creative approaches to investigating educational problems, her work focuses on the preparation of teachers and the under-representation of women and minorities in science, technology, engineering and mathematics careers. Her efforts have impacted university faculty members (organizing 14

research conferences attended by more than 500 faculty members from around the world), K-12 teachers (gaining grant support to pay tuition and a stipend for over 500 teachers to take graduate courses), and middle school and high school students (more than 5,000 students in two mathematics and science enrichment programs she has directed over the past 18 years). She has obtained more than 40 grants, published more than 85 research articles, delivered more than 60 presentations at national and international meetings, and supervised 15 doctoral and masters students. Dr. Berenson has

received the NCSU Outstanding Outreach and Extension Award and the Alumni Outstanding Outreach and Extension Award. She was elected Chair of the North American Chapter of the Psychology of Education, served on the Advisory Board of the Robert B. Davis Institute (Rutgers University Graduate School of Education), was appointed research fellow in 2002 at Queensland University of Technology in Brisbane, Australia, and chaired the International Research Conference to Investigate Mathematical Reasoning.

Fred R. DeJarnette, Professor of Mechanical and Aerospace Engineering; Director of the North Carolina Space Consortium



During his 35 years of distinguished service, Dr. Fred R. DeJarnette has been Graduate Administrator, Associate Head, and Head of the Department of Mechanical and Aerospace Engineering, served as director of the only university-based Mars Mission Research Center, and serves as Director of the NC Space Grant Consortium and as the NC State Liaison Professor in the National Institute of Aerospace.

His research in boundary layers and aerodynamic heating was used in the design of the tiles for the Space Shuttle Orbiter and has since been used for other high speed vehicles. Dr. DeJarnette has supervised 28 Ph.D. and 40 M.S. students. He is a fellow of the National Institute of Aerospace and the American Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics (receiving its Thermophysics Award and twice its Outstanding Advisor Citation). He has received the NC State Outstanding Teacher Award, the RJR Nabisco Award for Excellence in Teaching, Research, and Extension, the O. Max Gardner Award, and an Alumni Distinguished Graduate Professorship. He served as national president of Sigma Gamma Tau, the aerospace engineering honor society. He is active in bringing his knowledge of space science to the community, speaking at civic organizations, serving as a media commentator, and co-directing workshops for middle and high school teachers.

Thom J. Hodgson, James T. Ryan Professor and Distinguished University Professor of Industrial Engineering; Director of the Integrated Manufacturing Systems Engineering Institute



Dr. Thom Hodgson has served North Carolina State University for 22 years, including as Head of the NC State Department of Industrial Engineering (1983–1990) and Director of the NCSU Integrated Manufacturing Systems Engineering Institute (1995–present). He is one of the pioneers in the study of the design and analysis of supply chains, publishing over 71 research articles. He

was elected to the National Academy of Engineering in 2001. He served on the U.S. Army Science Board (1994-2000), receiving the U.S. Army Certificate of Appreciation for Patriotic Civilian Service. He was one of 125 inaugural Fellows of the Institute for Operations Research and the Management Sciences. He is a fellow of the Institute of Industrial Engineers, serving twice as its Vice-President and as editor of *IIE Transactions*, and receiving its highest and most esteemed honor, the Frank and Lillian Gilbreth Industrial Engineering Award. Dr. Hodgson's teaching awards include the C.A. Anderson Outstanding Faculty Award (a student-initiated award that he has received twice), Alumni Distinguished Graduate Professorship, and Albert G. Holzman Distinguished Educator Award (Institute of Industrial Engineers). Dr. Hodgson has graduated 31 Ph.D. and over 40 master's students.

Bruce S. Weir, William Neal Reynolds Distinguished Professor of Statistics and Genetics; Director of the Bioinformatics Research Center



Dr. Bruce S. Weir has built an international reputation in population genetics during his 29 years at NC State. His pioneering work in statistical genetics has broad impacts ranging from plant and animal breeding to bioinformatics to DNA forensics. He has published seven books and over 150 research papers (including one of the most cited papers in the field), supervised 20 Ph.D. and 15 postdoctoral students, and maintained a continuously funded National Institutes of Health Program Grant in statistical and quantitative genetics for 15 years. His service to NC State includes being the founding director of the Bioinformatics Research Center and establishing and obtaining training grant funding for the Bioinformatics Graduate Programs. He has also served his field by initiating the Summer Institute in Statistical Genetics, which provides training for scientists from around the world. Dr. Weir is a fellow in the American Statistical Association and the American Association for the Advancement of Science and an Honorary Fellow of the Royal Society of New Zealand. His awards include the Guggenheim Fellowship, the O. Max Gardner Award, the Kriz Study Award, D.D. Mason Award, USDA Superior Service Award Scientific Research (Group Award), Alumni Outstanding Research Award, Cook Memorial Prize for Mathematics, and Fulbright Travel Grant.

☞ Academic Costume ☞

Academic gowns represent a tradition handed down from the universities of the Middle Ages. These institutions were founded by the Church; the students, being clerics, were obliged to wear the prescribed gowns at all times. Round caps later became square mortarboards; the hoods, originally cowls attached to the gowns, could be slipped over the head for warmth.

Many European universities have distinctive caps and gowns which are different from those commonly used in this country. Some of the gowns are of bright colors and some are embellished with fur. A number of these may be noted in the procession.

The usual color for academic gowns in the United States is black. The bachelor's gown is worn closed; the master's and doctor's may be worn open or closed. The shape of the sleeve is the distinguishing mark of the gown: bachelor – long pointed sleeves; master – oblong, square cut in the back with an arc cut away in front; doctor – bell shaped.

Caps are black. The tassels for the Ph.D. degree are gold and those for other graduate and professional degrees may be of the color corresponding to the trimmings on the hoods.

Of all the components of the academic costume, the hood bears the heaviest symbolic burden. The hood must make clear the level of the degree, the faculty in which it was given, and the institution which awarded it. The level of the degree is shown by the size of the hood, the width of the velvet trimming, and in the case of doctors, by the shape. The bachelor's, master's, and doctor's hoods are three feet, three and one-half feet, and four feet long, respectively. The velvet trimming in the same order is two, three, and five inches and extends all around the hood on the exposed edge. This same trimming identifies the faculty in which the degree was awarded. For each faculty there is a corresponding color; so a glance at the trimming is all that is needed to identify the faculty. A partial list of the colors follows: Agriculture, maize; Architecture and Art, brown; Science, golden yellow; Economics, copper; Religion, scarlet; Speech, silver gray; Veterinary Medicine, gray; Textiles, wine red. The following faculties have the same color – dark blue: Anthropology, History, Languages, Literature, Philosophy, Political Science, and Sociology.
